problems....

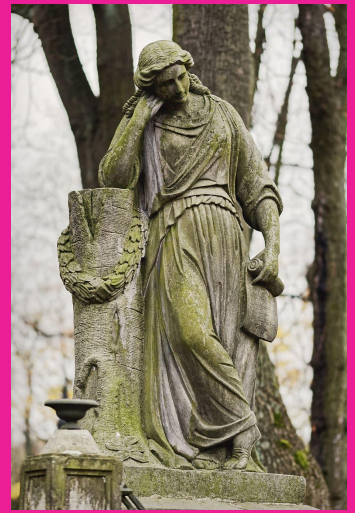


Wet grass means

Athena, also spelled Athene, in Greek religion, is the city protectress, goddess of war, handicraft, and practical reason. She is urban and civilized, and has great speed.

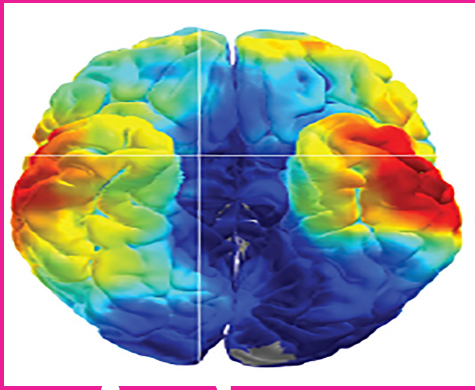
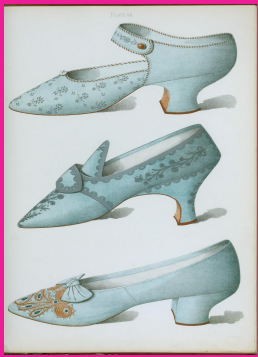
How can this help me with my design?

- Choose** an investigation from your inspiration!
- At least one [Creative Strategy](#)
- Sketch out ideas with possible materials
- Create** your artwork.
- Upload all iterations of sketches, thoughts, mapping.
- Create your story in slides.
- On the final slide, **Reflect** on your ideas, issues, drawings, and how it turned out.
